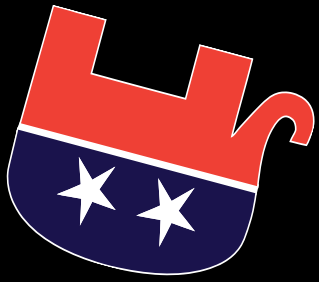


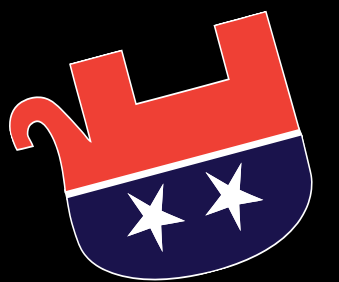

If Simonoff had his way, the Car Tax would be three times what it is today.

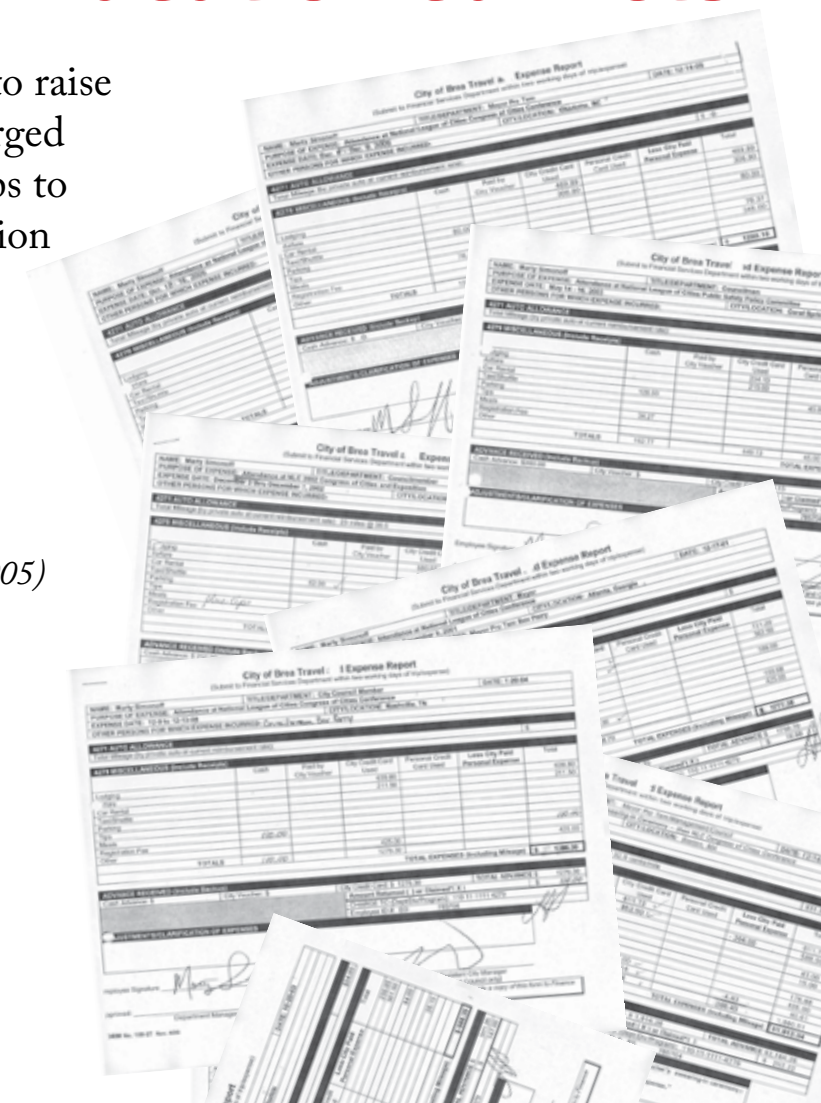


## Simonoff charged Taxpayers over \$50,000 for Vacation Junkets
